17 The movement of sediment in a stream depends on the size of the sediment and the speed of the stream.

Sediment Size

Sediment	Approximate Size
silt	3.9 micrometers–62.4 micrometers
sand	62.5 micrometers–1.9 millimeters
gravel	2 millimeters–64 millimeters

A stream's path becomes partially blocked, which causes the speed of the stream to decrease.



Particle Name	Diameter (mm)
Clay	Less than 0.004
Silt	0.004-0.06
Sand	0.07-2
Granule	2.1-4
Pebble	4.1-64
Cobble	64.1-256
Boulder	Greater than 256
