MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION COMMISSION FOR THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA

NOTICE OF THIS MEETING WAS FILED WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE ON THURSDAY, DECEMBER 12, 2014.

The members of the Workers' Compensation Commission for the state of Oklahoma met at 1915 N. Stiles Ave., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on December 18, 2014.

Members present: Chairman Troy Wilson, Commissioner Denise Engle, Commissioner Bob Gilliland.

Others in attendance on behalf of the Commission: Neal Leader, Rick Farmer, Clif Cypert, Jay Cannon, Andrea Bair, Kim Bailey, Holly Miller, and Tiffany Pratt.

Chairman Wilson expressed appreciation for those in attendance. After the roll was taken, he announced the presence of a quorum and the Statement of Compliance with the Open Meetings Act was read. The meeting was called to order at approximately 1:30 p.m.

Approval of Minutes

Chairman Wilson presented the minutes of the November 20, 2014 regular meeting for approval.

Motion: Commissioner Gilliland moved to approve the minutes of the November 20, 2014 regular meeting.

Second: Commissioner Engle.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

1. Proposed Opening of the Emergency Rulemaking Process to Consider Rule Amendments for the current Workers' Compensation Commission Emergency Rules

The Commission's current Emergency Rules are effective until September 14, 2015. The Commission considered opening the Emergency Rules process to provide for procedures not currently addressed and to amend existing sections to improve the Commission's processes. If approved by the Governor, Emergency Rules are considered promulgated and effective upon the Governor's signature and no later than twenty (20) days after the Commission's adoption of the rules.

Chairman Wilson recognized Kim Bailey to present a recommendation to the Commission to approve the opening of the Emergency Rulemaking Process.

Motion: Commissioner Engle moved to open rulemaking process for Emergency Rules.

Second: Chairman Wilson.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

2. Proposed Opening of the Permanent Rulemaking Process to Consider Permanent Rules for the Workers' Compensation Commission

The Commission's current Emergency Rules are effective until September 14, 2015. The Commission considered opening the Permanent Rulemaking process to provide the Commission with permanent rules that will incorporate the existing Emergency Rules with the proposed amendments to those Emergency Rules. If proposed Permanent Rules are adopted and submitted for legislative review on or before April 1, 2015, the Legislature will have until the end of the 2015 legislative session to approve or disapprove the rules.

Chairman Wilson recognized Kim Bailey to present a recommendation to the Commission to approve the opening of the Permanent Rulemaking Process.

Motion: Commissioner Engle moved to open rulemaking process for Permanent Rules.

Second: Chairman Wilson.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

3. Proposed Opening of the Form Adoption and Revision Process to Consider New Forms and Form Revisions to the current Workers' Compensation Commission forms

Title 85A O.S. § 22 provides before the adoption, amendment or modification of any form, the Commission shall give thirty (30) days' notice of its intended action and provide an opportunity for public comment, following the rulemaking process. The Commission considered opening the form adoption and revision process to provide for necessary modifications to forms and adopting new forms to provide for processes not currently addressed by the existing forms.

Chairman Wilson recognized Kim Bailey to present a recommendation to the Commission to approve the opening of the Form Adoption Process. The summary of proposed forms is identified as Workers' Compensation Commission Summary of Proposed New Forms and Revisions and is included as a part of these minutes.

Motion: Chairman Gilliland moved to open Form Adoption Process.

Second: Commissioner Engle.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

4. Discussion and Consideration of Determining the Surplus, if any, in the Oklahoma Option Insured Guaranty Fund

Title 85A O.S. § 208(A)(1) of the Oklahoma Employee Injury Benefit Act (Act) requires the Commission by December 31st to determine the surplus, if any, in the Oklahoma Option Insured Guaranty Fund, together with the additional amounts necessary to properly administer the Act for the following year.

Section 205 (D)(1) requires this fund to maintain a balance between One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00). The Commission shall determine the annual assessment rate on or before March 1st of each year. The Commission considered determining the surplus, if any, as this determination is a prerequisite to the later determination of an assessment rate.

Chairman Wilson recognized Andrea Bair, Deputy Insurance Services, to report to the Commission that there is no surplus in the Oklahoma Option Insured Guaranty Fund.

Motion: Commissioner Engle moved to accept the determination that there is no surplus in the Oklahoma Option Insured Guarantee Fund.

Second: Chairman Wilson.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

5. **Exercise of the Commission's Power, Under Title 85A, Section 19, to Prescribe Additional Duties and Responsibilities of the Commission Chair**

Under the provisions of Section 19 of Title 85A, Subsection E, the Commission is empowered to impose various additional duties and responsibilities upon the Chair. The Commission considered whether to impose the following additional duty and responsibility upon the Commission Chair: Vesting the Chair with the power and responsibility of entering into a contract involving an expenditure of \$100,000 or less, relating to a performance examination of the self-insured entities ensuring compliance with statutes and rules; verifying payroll and employee numbers; verifying reinsurance; evaluating reinsurance quality; verifying letters of credit and financial worthiness of the financial institutions; and other areas relating to the application, permitting and performance of self-insureds.

Chairman Wilson recognized Executive Director, Rick Farmer to explain his recommendation to the Commission to prescribe additional duties and responsibilities to the Commission Chair.

The WCC issues 143 private commercial self-insurance permits and 40 governmental entity permits each year. These permits cover 254,025 employees, 16% of the states employed work force. They involve \$198,395,000 in reserve collateral for current private sector self-insureds, \$118,331,600 in collateral for inactive private sector self-insureds, for a total reserve collateral of \$316,726,600. These permits are issued based on a brief application and some supporting documentation. The staff in the self-insurance office, Andrea Bair and Thomas Lewis, does a good job of examining the available data, but these data are limited.

Because of the aggregate level of responsibility, the WCC needs to take a deeper look at the risk of each self-insured entity. Commission administrators discussed this with OID, the SIGF and major TPAs. Each agreed that an outside independent examination of the risk would be the best way to assure that each self-insured company is capable of handling the risk and that the risk is properly securitized. It is my

understanding that this type of review had not been done before in Oklahoma. Some other states have conducted this type of review.

With that in mind, the Commission should empower the chairman to engage an outside consultant to examine the files, verify the reported information, issue a report on each file and produce a report on the overall portfolio.

The Self-Insurance Office has been operating with only two staff members for several months versus a previous staff of 6. That savings in personnel cost will more than fund the contract. The Commission will be well served by a review of the existing self-insured files and by a review of our processes.

Motion: Commission Engle moved to approve motion to prescribe additional duties and responsibilities to the Commission Chair.

Second: Commissioner Gilliland.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

6. Proposed Approval of Independent Medical Examiners for the Commission

Title 85A O.S. § 112 requires the Workers' Compensation Commission to create, maintain and review a list of licensed physicians who shall serve as independent medical examiners (IME). The Commission shall, to the best of its ability, include the most experienced and competent physicians in the specific fields of expertise utilized most often in the treatment of injured workers. The Commission considered approving the list of physicians presented at the meeting that have been vetted by the Medical Director and recommended to have their applications renewed.

Chairman Wilson recognized Dr. Jay Cannon, Medical Director, to present a recommendation to approve the renewals of 82 independent medical examiners (IME).

Motion: Commissioner Engle moved to approve the renewal of 82 IME's for the Commission, listed in Attachment Agenda Item 6.

Second: Chairman Wilson.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

7. Commission Ratification of Travel Vouchers from February 1, 2014- June 30, 2014

85A O.S. §23 states any commissioner or employee of the Commission shall be entitled to receive his or her necessary traveling expenses as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act. The expenses shall be certified by the person who incurred them and shall be allowed and paid on presentation of vouchers approved by the Commission. In accordance with this section, the Commission considered a vote to ratify the travel vouchers from February 1, 2014 – June 30, 2014.

Chairman Wilson recognized Clif Cypert, Deputy Director, to present his recommendation to the Commission to ratify travel vouchers dates February 1, 2014 to June 30, 2014. The list of vouchers is labeled as Agenda Item 7 and is included as part of these minutes.

Motion: Chairman Wilson moved to ratify travel vouchers from February 1, 2014 – June 30, 2014 in Attachment Agenda Item 7.

Second: Commissioner Engle.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

8. Consent Agenda for Travel Vouchers Currently Outstanding

85A O.S. §23 states any commissioner or employee of the Commission shall be entitled to receive his or her necessary traveling expenses as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act. The expenses shall be certified by the person who incurred them and shall be allowed and paid on presentation of vouchers approved by the Commission. In accordance with this section, the Commission considered a vote to approve the currently outstanding vouchers.

Chairman Wilson recognized Clif Cypert, Deputy Director, to present his recommendation to the Commission to approve the currently outstanding vouchers contained in the list labeled Agenda Item 8, and included as part of these minutes.

Motion: Commissioner Engle moved to approve vouchers excluding 7-9 in Attachment Agenda Item 8.

9. Commission Ratification of Payments Made from the Workers' Compensation Fund from February 1, 2014 – June 30, 2014

85A O.S. §22(A)(5) states that all expenditures in the administration of the act shall be allowed and paid from the Workers' Compensation Fund on the presentation of itemized vouchers approved by the Commission. In accordance with this section, the Commission considered a vote to ratify the vouchers from February 1, 2014 to June 30, 2014 for expenses of the Commission.

Chairman Wilson recognized Clif Cypert, Deputy Director to present his recommendations to the Commission to ratify payments made from Workers' Compensation Fund from February 1, 2014 – June 30, 2014. The list of payments is labeled as Agenda Item 9 and is included as part of these minutes.

Motion: Commissioner Gilliland moved to ratify payments made from Workers' Compensation Fund from February 1, 2014 – June 30, 2014.

Second: Commissioner Engle.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

11. **Reports**

Commissioner Gilliland's Report

Commissioner Gilliland presented a summary report on the case activity of the Administrative Law Judges and the Commission en banc. As of Dec 5, 2014, the Commission had 23,597 Form 2's filed. There have been 3,076 filed since February 1, 2014 and are on track to have approximately 4,000 in our first year. There are approximately 12 prehearing conferences and trial settings a day per ALJ. Prehearing conferences are being set within 3 weeks of request. The final orders of ALJ's are averaging 3 months. There have been 28 appeals. Fourteen of those appeals have been heard by the Commission. Two appeals have been dismissed; only one case is pending on appeal and is ready to be heard. Commissioner Gilliland also reported on the meetings held with attorneys from claimant's bar and respondent's bar to provide the Commission feedback on its processes. These meetings were very informative and have brought to light concerns and also ideas to make process run smoother and get cases heard.

Commissioner Engle's Report

Commissioner Engle presented a summary report on sample travel policy language from various agencies and the Arkansas WC Commission for Commission review. There are many options including internal controls that are more restrictive or the availability of the Commission leasing a vehicle through OMES. Commissioner Engle recommended not to take any action today and stated she would work on a brief

travel policy for possible policy adoption in the future.

12. Executive Session Pursuant to Title 25 O.S. § 307(B)(1) for the Purpose of Discussing Hiring, Promotion, Employment, Salary of Commission's Current and Future Law Clerks.

Motion: Chairman Wilson moved to adjourn to Executive Session.

Second: Commissioner Engle.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

13. Discussion and Possible Action on Hiring, Promoting, Salary or Employment of the Current or Future Law Clerks Discussed in Executive Session.

Motion: Commissioner Engle moved to reconvene from Executive Session back into Regular Meeting.

Second: Commissioner Gilliland.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

Motion: Commissioner Gilliland moved to promote Kim Bailey to the position of General Counsel of the Commission at an annual salary of \$85,000, subject to proper procedural requirements.

Second: Commissioner Engle.

Chairman Wilson stated that Kim Bailey is a diligent attorney who has invested a lot of time and effort in assisting the Commission with valuable research and guidance as a Law Clerk, and deserving of a promotion to General Counsel for the Commission.

Commissioner Gilliland agreed with the Chairman's comments, adding that Ms. Bailey's work in both research and writing is high quality and that she is well qualified for this position.

Mr. Neal Leader, Assistant Attorney General, said he has been impressed with the way Ms. Bailey anticipates the needs of the Commission, and prepares thorough information to assist with potential decision-making on issues the Commission may need to address.

Commissioner Engle said Kim Bailey has spent many additional hours working on special projects and needs of the Commission and was deserving of a promotion.

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

Motion: Chairman Wilson moved to hire a law clerk to fill the now vacant position and consider hiring another one to assist in handling the additional duties required due to the increased number of appeals.

Second: Commissioner Gilliland.

Commissioner Gilliland recommended amending motion renaming law clerk positions in a future meeting.

Second: Chairman Wilson

Those voting aye: Commissioner Engle, Commissioner Gilliland, and Chairman Wilson.

The motion carried.

Chairman Wilson announced that the Regular Meeting of the Commission for Thursday, January 15, 2014 has been cancelled and that the next Regular Meeting of the Commission has been rescheduled to Thursday, January 22, 2015.

Independent Medical Examiners

Title 85A grants the Commission the power to appoint and maintain a list of qualified Independent Medical Examiners who the ALJs can appoint to rate limitation of an injured worker or ask an opinion as to the treatment proposed by the treating physician. The Commission's Emergency rules require that to be appointed or reappointed an IME the physician is required to take Workers' Compensation Training approved by the Commission every two years.

The following list of IMEs recommended for approval are marked with an * if there is documentation that they have taken training in the past two years. Those who have not documented such training will have two years to provide proof of such training and will be notified in writing of this requirement.
