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City of Tulsa Purchasing Former Laura Dester Center located in the Pearl District

The former Laura Dester Center was constructed in 1948 as the Tulsa Boys' Home. Until the new Laura Dester Center was built in 2010, the Department of Human Services used the facility as a shelter to temporarily house abused and neglected children.

OMES is selling this property, located at 619 S. Quincy St. in Tulsa, OK, to the City of Tulsa through an interlocal agreement for \$955,000 plus closing and misc. costs. The City of Tulsa will use the property to mitigate future flooding potential. The area is a crucial component of what's needed to correct the drainage issues they are now suffering. This is a positive situation for



both parties, as the funds from the sale will go into the state's Maintenance of State Buildings Revolving Fund to be used for capital improvements to other state buildings.

Tulsa's Pearl District

The Pearl District is a neighborhood bordered north by Interstate 244, south by 11th St., west by U.S. Highway 75 and east by Utica Ave.
