REALS staff will soon be contacting all agencies, boards, commissions and public trusts with the State of Oklahoma as the beneficiary to update the real property inventory for the 2016 Real Property Asset Report. Information will be gathered and updated starting June 27, 2016. The State of Oklahoma owns a diverse and widely distributed array of properties. Included are historical properties, public colleges and universities, prisons, highways and rights-of-way, state parks and lodges, visitor's centers and offices that transact state buildings in all 77 counties. The State of Oklahoma owns 81 million square feet of space. Colleges and universities represent 64 percent of the state-owned property.
