**Deque's Deque University** offers several training modules that focus on creating more accessible content in tools like Microsoft Word, Microsoft PowerPoint, Adobe InDesign and Adobe Acrobat Pro. The training also includes a unit on general points around accessible technology.

If you create content in Microsoft Office, Adobe InDesign or if you work with Adobe PDF files, then this is a great chance to learn how to make your content more accessible to people with disabilities. It doesn't matter what your job role is, if you use these tools then you can make the digital world more accessible.

The training topics available are:
