



FNB Community Bank, Midwest City Recognizes Board Chairman for 60 Years of Service

William H. Croak, President and CEO, along with City of Midwest City Mayor Jack Fry and Oklahoma State Banking Department Assistant Deputy Commissioner Tony Reel recently recognized Mr. Robert H. Croak, Chairman of the Board, for 60 years with FNB Community Bank. On Monday, September 8, the staff at FNB presented Mr. Croak with a Recognition Certificate and launched 60 balloons in his honor.



Mr. Croak's banking career began on September 8, 1954, when he was hired by the then-named American State Bank to work on a part-time basis as a messenger in the Mail Department. He began full-time employment with the Bank as Assistant Cashier in Loan Collections in 1963. He was elected to the then First National Bank of Midwest City Board of Directors in 1971 and became President and CEO in 1986.

In 1988, Mr. Croak was elected Vice Chairman of the Bank's Board and in 1995 he was elected President and Board Chairman of First National Bank of Midwest City and First Midwest Bancorp, Inc. and continued as such when it was reorganized into First Midwest Acquisition Corporation in May 2002. He continues his service to the now-named FNB Community Bank as Chairman of the Board.
