The Muscogee (Creek) Nation Family Violence Prevention Program is offering two FREE 1-day Domestic/Sexual Violence Training opportunities. Training is open to law enforcement & advocates, topics include: assessing lethality and threats, interpreting the power, control and manipulation, motive and impact of strangulation, stalking and counter-stalking, and responding to children exposed to violence in the home. CLEET provides a total of 8 hours for completing the training.

TRAINING FACILITATOR: Lt. Mark Wynn is known nationally and internationally for his work and expertise in the area of domestic and sexual violence prevention training and consultation. He was a 21 year member of the Nashville Metropolitan Police Department—Served as Lieutenant to the Domestic Violence Division—and as a member of the Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Team for 15 years. He is a 1994 graduate of the Federal Bureau of Investigation National Academy, and also co-wrote the Police Officer Standards and Training certified curriculum on Law Enforcement Intervention and Investigation to Domestic and Sexual Violence (Tennessee). In 2012 he received the Family Justice Center Alliance Lifetime Achievement Award.
