NOTE: All forms must be completed and approval by the Fire Chief <u>before</u> you can apply to the Oklahoma Tax Commission. <u>After your Fire Chief approves your forms</u>, Taxpayers who electronically file their income tax returns should <u>mail the approved form attached to the Form 511EF to the Oklahoma Tax Commission</u>. The Form 511EF is the signature document for an electronically filed return and without it the Firefighter Tax Credit form may not be matched with their income tax return. All other taxpayers should <u>mail the approved form with their tax return</u>. The addresses are located on the tax form.

wards the completion of Support and Basic Firefighter, or an equivalent program by the end of the year.

All applicants *must* be a member in good standing with the volunteer fire department on which he/she serves. The applicant must have had the opportunity to attend, and participated in all annual training as required by federal and state authorities for Current Tax Year. 
