Course Overview: The Ambulance Strike Team Leaders Training Program will prepare qualified individuals with the skills and training necessary to lead an Ambulance Strike Team (AST) through the following responsibilities: Assuring the safety and operability of Strike Team personnel and equipment; Coordinating the movement of the personnel and equipment traveling to and returning from an incident; Supervising the operational deployment of the team at the incident, as directed by the Division/Group Supervisor, Operations Section Chief, or Incident Commander; Maintaining familiarity with personnel and equipment operations, including assembly, response, and direct actions of the assigned units, keeping the team accounted for at all times; Contacting appropriate Incident personnel with problems encountered on the incident, including mechanical, operational, or logistical issues; Ensuring vehicles have adequate communications capability; Maintaining effective and positive public relations during the incident; Prior to deployment, determining mission duration, special circumstances, reporting location and contact information; Ensuring completion and submission of ICS documents for timekeeping and Demobilization.

In summary, the AST Leader must have the capability and experience to manage, coordinate, and direct the actions of the ambulance crews at a wide variety of emergency situations. This includes maintaining all required records, and ensuring the logistical needs of all personnel are met during the entire activation of the team.
