They made contact with the AG office to discuss the AG opinion; maybe writing a new opinion or an explanation of the opinion. There are 85 local social host ordinances; there has been new interest in looking in areas of the state that is not owned by the municipal courts. ODMHSAS is looking into doing research on signage in retail locations on the risk of drinking alcohol while pregnant (fetal alcohol syndrome).

Oklahoma has no law in restricting alcohol advertising or signage. Ms. Hawkins has talked to ODMHSAS leadership about speaking with Chief of Police concerning the advertising/signage in retail locations. No action was taken.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING 2M2L (ENFORCING UNDERAGE DRINKING LAWS PROGRAM) REPORT

Ms. Hawkins introduced Ms. Adrienne Rollins as the new 2M2L Coordinator. Ms. Rollins provided a handout. Ms. Rollins discussed the 2M2L Initiative which includes a 10 member state youth council that will serve across the State of Oklahoma. Their first meeting will be February 27, 2010, there will be specialized trainings in media advocacy and environmental prevention; as well as, provide youth leadership mini-camps and conferences. A second part of the initiative included law enforcement task forces in Oklahoma City and Tulsa; both will be task forces in the County Sheriff's Office. Stipends will be paid to task forces in order to develop cross jurisdictional enforcement and the contracts began on January 1, 2010. There will be 2M2L trainings in Spring 2010 in Oklahoma City; the dates for Woodward, Lawton and McAlester trainings will be announced soon. There will be four regional coordinators. The Reality Parties had a great impact on the communities and APRCs are currently planning future home tours with several communities. No action was taken.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE OKLAHOMA UNDERAGE DRINKING PREVENTION VIDEOS

Ms. Hawkins informed the task force that SAMHSA funded 11 states to produce videos and each state worked with Macro International to do the videos. Ms. Jessica Davis informed the task force that Oklahoma decided to do two videos, 1 geared towards youth and 1 towards adults. Ms. Davis provided a handout with the dissemination plans for both videos. The video premier will be at the 3rd Annual ODMHSAS Combined Conference in January. No action was taken.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING OKLAHOMA'S MENTAL HEALTH, PREVENTION AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE CONFERENCE

Ms. Hawkins stated that Prevention has a keynote speaker, Dr. Dennis Embry. The 3rd Annual ODMHSAS Combined Conference will take place January 27-29, 2010, at Embassy Suites in Norman, Oklahoma. There may be special meetings taking place during the conference. No action was taken.
