## Overview

## Presenter Information



Mickey Eliason, Ph.D. has studied LGBT health for the past twenty years, first at the University of Iowa, where she had faculty positions in Nursing, Psychology, Education, and Sexuality Studies over the years; and now at San Francisco State University. Her research has focused on sexual identity development and LGBT health topics such as alcohol, drug and tobacco problems, suicide, and health care provider attitudes. She has also done workforce development training for professionals in public health, nursing, mental health and substance abuse in Iowa and California.




