WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Ms. Jamie Piatt called the August 17, 2010 Oklahoma State Epidemiological Outcomes Workgroup (SEOW) meeting to order and proceeded with introductions of the participants.

DATA GAPS

The SEOW members discussed the data gaps in prescription drugs prescribed and filled. There are counties that have a small population and they may see a doctor in a different county and fill their prescriptions in a different county rather than the county the person resides. The discussion continued about the data gaps in college surveying data and also the need for data of those who

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do not attend college but are in the same age group of 18-25 years of age. Ms. Piatt suggested the members should email her with any other data gaps.

NASDUH MAP

Ms. Piatt informed the SEOW members the Oklahoma Prevention Collaborative Leadership members preferred the equity model method than the hot spot method. Discussion continued on choosing a county or counties for the pilot program of prescription drugs. The members discussed not funding Tulsa because it's so huge and we should target smaller communities; therefore better data could be gained. Counties that will perform the enhanced efforts model will be chosen by Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services staff, Oklahoma Prevention Leadership Collaborative members and APRCs will still have control to go into the counties and communities to perform the SPF model. There was discussion to create a sub-group to look at the information and put together a methodology piece.

UPCOMING SEOW MEETINGS

It was consensus of the group to meet quarterly. Ms. Piatt suggested that the SEOW could be utilized for more than just SPF. If other agencies needed to utilize SEOW for other projects and look at data, that's something that could be done.
