**CALL TO ORDER**

Ms. Jessica Hawkins called the January 18, 2011 Underage Drinking Prevention Committee meeting to order.

**WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS**

Ms. Hawkins welcomed the members and the guests.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The November meeting minutes were distributed and reviewed by the members. Ms. Raye Shilen made a motion to approve the November meeting minutes. Dr. Donald Baker seconded the approval of the November meeting minutes. The minutes were approved.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE OKLAHOMA PREVENTION POLICY ALLIANCE (OPPA) REPORT**

Ms. Raye Shilen informed the members of the Social Host bill not being authored by Representative Kris Steele. It will be authored by Representative Dan Kirby with the help of Representative Steele. The language is the same and everything is going smoothly. A new issue came up at the end of December pertaining to wine in grocery stores. Ms. Shilen stated there will be an OPPA meeting tomorrow and a bill may be authored by Representative Al McAffrey; Ms. Shilen continued with stating OPPA is looking for a lot of support and working with ABLE on this issue.

Ms. Hawkins stated if Oklahoma City and Tulsa allow alcohol in grocery and convenience stores, the Constitution would be required to change this and also require a vote of the people. Ms. Hawkins informed the members of the policy brief that's in the development process. No action was taken.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING ENFORCING THE UNDERAGE DRINKING LAWS (EUDL) UPDATE**

Ms. Adrienne Rollins introduced a member of the 2M2L Youth Advisory Council, Ms. Monica Zyzak. Ms. Rollins continued by stating the Youth Advisory Council had met once in December. Club stipends are due on January 30<sup>th</sup>, the Council will meet again

in February and review the applications for the stipends. During February 23-24, there will be a Youth Leadership Institute Train the Trainer training. There's a law enforcement and community based training on February 8-9 in Woodward. There will be upcoming trainings in Oklahoma City on March 24-25 with March 23 possibly hosting a reception for law enforcement and other preventionists across the state. Dates for the youth training are July 24-26 with July 28 possibly being held for a SADD Conference in Norman at the Postal Training Center. Beginning of June will be the rural youth training. No action was taken.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE STRATEGIC PREVENTION FRAMEWORK STATE INCENTIVE GRANT (SPF-SIG)**

Ms. Hawkins provided a brief update. ODMHSAS staff is currently working on the continuation application and on bid packets for the communities. There's hope to have it out in February; funding 17 sites. Communities will conduct a survey of their community; a work plan; and turn it back into ODMHSAS for approval. Also ODMHSAS is building a data query system and contracting with a group to keep the information up to date in the query system. Anyone in the prevention field or public will have access. It should be up and running by summer. The system will help Prevention. No action was taken.

**DICUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE OKLAHOMA STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (OSDE) UPDATE**

No information provided. No action was taken.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING BOATING UNDER THE INFLUENCE**

Ms. Hawkins introduced Ms. Stacy Puckett with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police. Ms Puckett spoke about the accident that taken place at Lake Eufaula last summer. She's hoping to lower the alcohol level of recreational drinking while boating on lakes. There's a different alcohol level on the lake than driving on land. Over 100 boating alcohol related incidents with 48 fatalities occurred in 2010. Ms. Puckett stated law enforcement said there's little law enforcement of alcohol on the water ways. Legislation has been filed, SB1140 authored by Senator Bill Brown. Oklahoma is one of few states that have the .10 alcohol law on water ways. Ms. Hawkins informed Ms. Puckett that Oklahoma Prevention Injury Advisory Committee voted to support the boating bill. The Legislation will only deal with blood alcohol level. There was a suggestion to take a vote of support on any bills at the next meeting. No action was taken.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LAWS ENFORCEMENT (ABLE) COMMISSION'S 2011 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES**

Mr. Jim Hughes stated they are trying to tighten up on Oklahoma wineries to do sampling on or off site. It's not in line with what other states are doing; reduce sample sizes to one ounce off premise. Mr. Hughes informed the committee of Four Loko's return, which is reformulated without caffeine. It's still in the liquor stores. Oklahoma was seen as a leader on the Four Loko issue. Mr. Hughes added a lot of issues hurt the system on allowing alcohol in grocery store/convenient stores. No action was taken.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES' (ODMHSAS) 2011 LEGISLATIVE UPDATE**

Ms. Hawkins announced ODMHSAS is working with OPPA on Social Host. As of yet, there's no updates from Leadership. No action was taken.

**NEW BUSINESS**

There will be a press conference in the Governor's Large Room on texting while driving.
