The Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services will host the 2012 Children's Behavioral Health Conference, May 15 – 17, 2012 at the Tulsa Southern Hills Marriott in Tulsa, OK. The theme this year is "Finding the Me I Was Born to Be" and will focus on reducing stigma and promoting mental health as a part of overall wellness; increasing access to effective mental health and substance abuse treatment; creating culturally and linguistically competent services; building youth and family leadership; and advocating for children, youth and families. Scholarships are available to undergraduate students interested in the behavioral health or related fields. The scholarship will cover conference registration for the 3 day conference, which includes light refreshments and a luncheon on May 17. Students will need to make their own sleeping arrangements. A requirement of the scholarship is that each student will be required to complete 5 hours of volunteer work. Volunteer tasks will depend on the day you volunteer. Examples of assignments include: packing conference bags, creating name badges, registration of conference attendees, and room monitoring during workshops. **Volunteer days available:** *May 7 – 11, 2012 and May 14 – 17, 2012*
