Hand Delivered bids will be received at the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Building, Commission Room, 200 NE 21st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 on October 30, 2015 until 10:30 AM. Bids will be opened and publicly read at 10:30 AM on October 30, 2015.

Description of Property:

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, T16N, R25E, in Adair County, Oklahoma. Said parcel of land being described by metes and bounds as follows:




