Hand Delivered bids will be received at the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Building, Commission Room, 200 NE 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 on November 19, 2015 until 10:30 AM. Bids will be opened at 10:30 AM and publicly read at 11:00 AM on November 19, 2015.

### Description of Property:

Containing 9.13 acres, more or less.


