Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Latimer County claims Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate for November

In November 2011, **Latimer County** again posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate at 10.1 percent. **Okmulgee County** recorded the state's second highest county rate, and **McCurtain County** accounted for the third highest monthly rate. **Roger Mills County** provided Oklahoma's lowest county rate in November. For the month, only two of Oklahoma's 77 counties (Adair and Ottawa) reported unemployment rate increases.


