Crashes and Fatalities

The New Year's Holiday period for 2003-2004 was a total of 30 hours which began at 6 p.m. on December 31, 2003 and ended at midnight on January 1, 2004.

During this time period, there were four persons killed in three fatal crashes.

Fatalities & Safety Equipment

Of the four fatalities, two were drivers and two were passengers. All four fatalities were in pickup trucks and all four were not using safety equipment.

Driver Age & Gender

The four drivers involved in fatal crashes ranged in age from 18 to 38. Three of the drivers were male and one was female.

Causes

One fatal crash was caused by failure to stop and two fatal crashes were caused by unsafe speed.

Number of Vehicles Involved

Two of the fatal crashes involved one vehicle and one fatal crash involved two vehicles.
