Crashes, Injuries & Fatalities


In 2006, Oklahoma reported 268 crashes involving a school bus which is less than one percent of the total number of crashes. These crashes involved 675 persons and resulted in no fatalities and 227 persons injured.

Of the 227 persons injured, 143 were school bus occupants. Of the 143 school bus occupants injured, 14 were drivers and 129 were passengers.

School Bus Driver Age & Gender

There were 267 school bus drivers involved in School Bus Involved crashes in 2006. Some 12.7% of the school bus drivers were age 56-60, 10.9% were age 46-50, 10.1% were age 51-55 and 10.1% were age 66-70.

Some 64.8% of the school bus drivers in School Bus Involved crashes were male and 34.5% were female.



Cause of Crashes

The five primary causes of School Bus Involved crashes in 2006 were: Inattention (18.3%), Improper Turn (17.2%), Failed to Yield (16.4%), Other Improper Act Movement (11.9%) and Followed Too Closely (8.2%).
