## Crashes, Fatalities & Injuries

The Thanksgiving Holiday period in 2011 was a total of 102 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, November 23 and ended at midnight on Sunday, November 27. During this time period there were six persons killed in four fatal crashes. One of the six fatalities occurred in an alcohol-related crash.

## Fatalities & Safety Equipment

Of the six fatalities, five were occupants in a passenger vehicle/pickup truck and one was a motorcyclist. One of the vehicle occupant fatalities was unrestrained.

The motorcyclist fatality was not wearing a safety helmet.
