Crashes & Fatalities

The 2015 Independence Day Holiday was a total of 78 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Thursday, July 2 and ended at midnight on Sunday, July 5. During this time period, 12 persons were killed in 11 fatal crashes. Three of the 12 fatalities occurred in alcohol/drug-related crashes.

Five fatalities were occupants of a passenger vehicle, one was an occupant of a pickup truck, five were motorcyclists and one was a pedestrian.

Of the six occupants of a passenger vehicle/pickup truck, two were unrestrained, two were restrained and restraint use for two occupants was unknown. All five of the motorcyclist fatalities were not wearing a helmet.
