

### Crashes & Fatalities

The 2015 Memorial Day holiday was a total of 78 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Friday, May 22 and ended at midnight on Monday, May 25. During this time period, eight persons were killed in seven fatal crashes. Two of the eight fatalities occurred in alcohol/drug-related crashes.

Five fatalities were occupants of a passenger vehicle, two were occupants of a pickup truck and one was a pedestrian.

Of the seven occupants of a passenger vehicle/pickup truck, three were unrestrained.
