	BILL	AUTHOR	OKLAHOMA STATUTE AFFECTED	SUMMARY OF PROVISION
1	HB1608	ENNS SYKES	21 §1289.23 – Concealed Firearm For Off-Duty Police Officer	Allows peace officers to carry personal rifle or shotgun along with approved service weapons both on and off duty. Sent to Governor 5/3/18.
2	HB2527	CLEVELAND DAHM	21 §1277 – Unlawful Carry in Certain Places	Allows sheriffs to authorize county employees with SDA licenses to carry in courthouses, but not in courtrooms, jails or sheriff's offices. Signed by Governor 5/8/18. Effective 11/1/18.
3	HB2625	WEST (KEVIN) RITZE BERGSTROM	21 §1289.8 – Carry Weapon	Minor language change – strikes “anywhere in” and replaces with “throughout” in describing where retired peace officers can carry in Oklahoma. Signed by Governor 4/18/18. Effective 11/1/18.
4	HB2632	BABINEC BERGSTROM	21 §1289.25 – Physical or Deadly Force Against Intruder	Authorizes defensive force in places of worship. Signed by Governor 5/1/18. Effective 11/1/18.
5	HB2889	TAYLOR SCOTT	21 §1290.12 – Procedure for Application	Allows Sheriffs to charge a fee of \$25 for fingerprinting SDA applicants. Signed by Governor 5/1/18. Effective 11/1/18.
6	HB3353	(SEAN) ROBERTS HILBERT DAHM	21 §1272 – Unlawful Carry 21 §1277 – Unlawful Carry in Certain Places 21 §1290.8 – Possession of License Notification to Police of Gun	Removes “billy” from the list of items it is unlawful to carry. Adds wildlife refuge and wildlife management area to places not prohibited. Removes the word “bow,” in describing hunting as it relates to authorizing carry while engaged in hunting or fishing and adds the word, “scouting.” Signed by Governor 4/23/18. Effective 11/1/18.
