NOTICE OF ELECTION AND CANDIDATES

On Tuesday, December 1, 2015, the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission (OSRC) will conduct an election for a representative of Adair County and of Cherokee County to serve four-year terms on the 12-member OSRC Board of Commissioners.

During the candidate filing period (November 16 – 18, 2015) two candidates filed for Adair County; four filed for Cherokee County; and one filed for Delaware County. Those individuals are:

Mr. Steven B. Randall filed unopposed and is the Delaware County Representative.

This public notice will be conspicuously posted within Adair and Cherokee counties at five (5) locations prior to the election. It also will be published twice in a newspaper qualified to publish legal notices (per Title 25 O.S. Section 106) serving Adair and Cherokee counties, and electronically mailed to those individuals listed on the OSRC email list.

In order to vote, registered voters who reside, own real property or a residential structure within 660 feet of a scenic river must have filed a voter registration qualification affidavit with the OSRC between 2001 and Saturday, November 7, 2015, and be qualified to vote on election day.

Absentee voting is not permitted. Polling will be open to qualified voters to cast ballots on the Election Day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the following county polling locations:

Adair County – Chewey Area Community Center, Chewey, Oklahoma

Cherokee County – OSRC Headquarters 15971 Hwy #10 (located two (2) miles northeast of Tahlequah, Oklahoma

The election will be conducted pursuant to provisions of Title 82 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 1461 and Oklahoma Administrative Code 630: Scenic Rivers Commission Chapter 3 Election Procedures.
