RULE IMPACT STATEMENT

For rulemaking hearing and adoption by the
Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission
On November 17, 2015

- a. **What is the purpose of the revisions?** The revisions are intended to clarify existing rules.
- b. **What classes of people will be affected, and are there any cost impacts?** The members of the public and commercial float operators will benefit by clearer rules, and there are no costs involved.
- c. **What classes of people will benefit?** The floating public and river front property owners.
- d. **What is the probable economic impact on classes affected and on political subdivisions?** None, although the commercial float operators will benefit by having less damage done to their flotation devices by concise and clearer rules.
