AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DAVIS, OKLAHOMA, AND DESIGNATING THE AREA KNOWN AS THE DONALD J. BRITTIN AND MARGARET A. BRITTIN PROPERTY INCLUDED IN SUCH EXTENSION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING THAT IF ANY PART OR PARTS HEREOF BE HELD INVALID OR INEFFECTIVE, THE REMAINING PORTIONS SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAVIS, OKLAHOMA

SECTION I: That the corporate limits of the City of Davis, Oklahoma, be, and are hereby extended to include the following described property in Murray County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Commencing at a point where the centerline of U. S. Highway No. 77 intersects with the present North boundary of the City of Davis municipal boundary; thence in a Northerly direction one (1) foot either side of the centerline of said U. S. Highway No. 77 approximately 1.2 miles to the centerline of the County Road shown in the records of the Murray County Clerk in Book 59 at page 389 and located on the South twenty feet of the SW/4 SE/4 NW/4, Section 29-1N-2E, lying East of said U. S. Highway No. 77; thence East one (1) foot either side of the centerline of said County Road approximately 610.24 feet to the Southwest corner of the SW/4 SE/4 SE/4 NW/4, Section 29-1N-2E; thence to include all of the said SW/4 SE/4 SE/4 NW/4, Section 29-1N-2E, all in Murray County, Oklahoma.

SECTION II: That at least three-fourths of the registered voters and the owners of at least three-fourths (in value) of said property, which is adjacent and contiguous to the City of Davis, have requested annexation by signing and filing a Petition with the Davis City Clerk. Notice of the presentation of said Petition has been published once each week for two (2) successive weeks in The Davis News, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Davis. Annexation of said property would be in the best interests and would redound to the benefit of the City of Davis and the residents thereof.

SECTION III: That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith, be, and are hereby repealed.
