ORDINANCE NO. 2002-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, OKLAHOMA, ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the property described below, all lying within Bryan County, Oklahoma, is adjacent to the current corporate limits of the Town, insofar as it does not currently lie within the current corporate limits of the Town, to-wit:

The West 208.76' of the SE/4 of Section 30, Township 6 South, Range 8 East, insofar as said property lies south of the south right-of-way line of the railroad crossing said Section,

LESS AND EXCEPT that portion which lies more than 15.815 chains north of the south line of said Section, only insofar as said property lies east of the east right-of-way line of the public road proceeding more or less along the west right-of-way line of said Section, said road being known as Church Street.



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and,

WHEREAS, notice has been published and mailed as required by applicable law regarding the annexation of said property, and

WHEREAS, prior to the publication of said notice, a plan to extend appropriate town services to the said property has been prepared, said plan complying fully with applicable law, and said plan has been available for public inspection as required by applicable law, and

WHEREAS, the said property has an assessed valuation less than the assessed valuation of the Town, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held as required by applicable law on the 16th day of May, 2002, regarding annexation of the said property, and proper notice was given of said hearing as required by applicable law, and

WHEREAS, annexation of the said property will benefit the Town and will serve the public interest, and

WHEREAS, an emergency currently exists pursuant to 11 O.S. § 14-103, and it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town for this annexation to go into effect immediately upon passage by the Board of Trustees,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the

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Town of Mead, Oklahoma, that the property described above is hereby annexed to and made a part of the corporate limits of the Town of Mead, insofar as it was not previously within the corporate limits of the Town, pursuant to 11 O.S. § 21-104. Additionally, the Plan for Extension of Municipal Services to Territory Annexed to the Town of Mead, Oklahoma, which is attached hereto, is incorporated herein and made a part hereof by reference.

FURTHER, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists pursuant to 11 O.S. § 14-103, and that this ordinance shall therefore go into effect immediately upon passage by the Board of Trustees.

1. **TERRITORY TO BE ANNEXED.**

The territory to be annexed to the Town pursuant to this Plan is the following property, insofar as said property does not lie within the current limits of the Town, all lying in Bryan County, Oklahoma, and described as follows with reference to the Indian Base and Meridian, to-wit:

The West 208.76' of the SE/4 of Section 30, Township 6 South, Range 8 East, insofar as said property lies south of the south right-of-way line of the railroad crossing said Section,



In the event that services are provided to those residing within current Town boundaries, those services will be provided, as appropriate, to the annexed territory within one (1) year time after provision of such services becomes appropriate, unless a longer period would be a reasonable time.
