AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ANNEXATION OF REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF PRAGUE, OKLAHOMA AS SET FORTH BELOW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PRAGUE, OKLAHOMA.

SECTION I: The owners of a majority of the whole number of acres of the tracts and property, premises, lands and territory hereinafter described having made and executed a consent in writing that the said tracts, property, premises, lands and territory shall be added and annexed to the city limits of the City of Prague, Oklahoma, the same being situated in Lincoln County, Oklahoma, and adjacent to or adjoining the city limits of said City, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW/c NW/4) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Six (6) East of the Indian Meridian, thence North 90°00'00" East along the North line of said Northwest Quarter, a distance of 1322.72 feet; thence South 00°58' 40" East a distance of 454.12 feet to a point, said point being the point of beginning; thence North 65°30'06" East a distance of 190.86 feet; thence South 00°58'40" East a distance of 190.00 feet; thence North 82° 59'32" East a distance of 163.91 feet; thence North 00°58'41" West a distance of 170.00 feet; thence North 90°00'00" East and parallel with said North line a distance of 170.56 feet; thence South 2°35'53" East a distance of 532.55 feet; thence South 90°00'00" West and parallel with said North line a distance of 523.67 feet; thence North 00°58'41" West a distance of 452.92 feet to the point of beginning, containing 5.47 acres more or less. Less and except all the oil, gas and other minerals together with all improvements thereon and easements and appurtenances belonging thereto.

SECTION II – EMERGENCY CLAUSE: It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and welfare of the City of Prague, and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

Passed and approved, with the Emergency Clause having been voted upon separately, this 9th day of Oct, 2000.
