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Chairman Robert Gilliland Announces Re-appointment of Louis Pippin to Self-insurance Guaranty Fund Board

OKLAHOMA CITY – Chairman Robert Gilliland today announced the re-appointment of Louis Pippin to the Workers' Compensation Commission's Self-insurance Guaranty Fund (SIGF) Board.

Pippin, of Oklahoma City, fulfilled the remainder of an unexpired term over the past year and will now serve a three-year term ending in November 2018. He will be serving as a licensed claims adjuster affiliated with an approved group self-insurance association.

He is currently the Vice President of Midlands Claim Administrators, Inc., a company that provides expertise as one of the top excess workers' compensation providers in the United States.

“Louis Pippin’s combined experience in self-insurance, business, and workers’ compensation brings a valuable perspective to the Board,” said Gilliland. “His leadership and dedication will serve injured workers and our other workers' compensation partners well.”

Pippin was also appointed by Oklahoma Governor, Mary Fallin, to serve as a member of the Electronic Data Interchange Advisory Committee in 2012.

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
